On behalf of the management and staff of Bhawani Dayal Arya College, I would like to thank you for your continuous support and for encouraging your children to resume schooling which has allowed the students to continue with their education. With your collaboration and support, we are optimistic that we will be able to provide the best quality education and holistic learning to your children.

1. COVID 19 Precautionary Measures

It is mandatory to follow all COVID 19 precautionary measures for the safety of our students and teachers. COVID safety messages are displayed inside all the classrooms as well around school. Students the continuously reminded about the precautionary measures during morning and afternoon form time and during syndicate assemblies. Students are also reminded to wash their hands before entering the classrooms. Multiple wash stations are available to avoid overcrowding of students.

2. Entry into the School Premises

Screening stations have been set up at both entry points. Temperature check is compulsory for all students, teachers and visitors. Anyone with a temperature above 37.5 °C and those who appear symptomatic will be denied entry. All visitors must show their vaccination cards and entry will only be granted if the person is fully vaccinated. Masks should be worn at all times. **No mask no entry** policy is strictly followed.

3. Text Book Return

Parents/Guardians are requested to remind the students to return all the text books to the subject teachers. All text books issued to the students remain the property of the college and should be returned in proper condition. In case the book is lost or damaged, it should be replaced within the collection period.

4. Literacy Program

Parents are reminded that the literacy program has resumed from 07/03/2022 and is being conducted from 7.45 am to 8.00 am every morning. The objective of the program is to provide additional support to students which will enable them to improve their literacy skills.

5. Holi Celebration

Holi will be celebrated in school on the 18/03/2022. Please note, that as Holi falls on Saturday (19/03/2022) this year, there will be no holiday for this occasion.

6. Mobile Phones/Electronic Gadgets

Despite frequent reminders, students are still bringing the aforementioned items to school. These items are strictly forbidden and students should not bring such gadgets to school. These items will be confiscated and returned to the parents if found in possession by the students. The school will not be responsible for any loss or theft of these items.

7. Social Media/Online Games

Parents are requested to be more vigilant and ensure that students do not spend too much time on social media. It has been brought to our attention that some students spend a lot of time playing games or posting pictures online. We will be strictly monitoring students

to ensure that they do not post pictures or videos in school uniform. In case any such videos or pictures are brought to our attention, parents will be called and students will be asked to delete them immediately.

8. Arrival/Departure Time

Students should arrive in school between 7.00 am to 8.00 am every morning and should depart at 3.20 pm Mon-Thurs and 3.00 pm on Fridays. It has been observed that some students do not report straight to school as they arrive in the morning and wait for their friends. It has also been reported that some students do not go home straight after school and are seen sitting and talking at the bus stop. Please note that when left unsupervised, students can get involved in unwanted activities and accidents.

9. Final Assessment

The Final Assessment for Years 9 to 11 will be conducted from 11/03/2022 to 17/03/2022 as per the timetable given below. Parents are

requested to encourage their children to prepare well for this assessment. Please note that it is compulsory for students to sit for all the papers.

10. Annual Awards

The BDAC Annual Awards day for the academic year 2021 will be held on the 31/03/2022 in school. However, as the COVID protocols are still in place and we are still practising social distancing, the ceremony will only include management, staff and recipients of the awards only.

11. School Break (04/04/22-08/04/2022)

The academic year 2021 will conclude on Friday (01/04/2022). Term 1, 2022 begins on the **11/04/2022** after one week break. Parents are requested to supervise the students during the break and assist them to prepare well for the new academic year.
